How to harvest your horse's hair



 Brush tail to remove loose dirt and untangle hair



2. Separate a small section of hair from the underside of the tail where the cut will be less noticeable and the hair is longer and stronger for braiding.



3. Cut the hair close to the bone.

 Repeat the process in different areas until you have a bundle of hair about a pinkies width in diameter.



Amount of hair needed for a bracelet should be a pinkies width in diameter the whole length and as long as possible.



Amount of hair needed for a necklace should be a pinkies width in diameter the whole length and as long as possible. Bind the hair with a rubber band (not tape), brush again and put in a plastic ziplock baggie.

The hair does not need to be washed before you send it. However \$50.00 will be charged if hair is not combed out before mailing.
